Time	Ref (Ex)	Description
	Ex 2	Moses born, kills Egyptian, and flees to Midian.
	Ex 7:7	Moses is 80 yr old and Aaron is 88 yr old when they come before pharaoh.
	Ex 7:8-13	The Lord sends Moses & Aaron to Pharaoh and had the lay down the staff and it turned into a snake which ate the magician's snakes.
	Ex 7:14-24	The Nile is turned to blood
	Ex 7:25	Seven days after the Lord struck the Nile the Lord sent Moses to Pharaoh to warn of plague of frogs.
	Ex 7:8-13	Plague of frogs
	Ex 8:16-19	Plague of gnats (or lice possibly)
	Ex 8:20-32	Plague of flies
	Ex 9:1-7	Plague on livestock
	Ex 9:8-12	Plague of boils
	Ex 9:13-35	Plague of hail
	Ex 10:1-20	Plague of locust
	Ex 10:21-29	Plague of darkness for 3 days
	Ex 11	Warning of plague of first born.
	Ex 12:1-24	The Lord tells Moses how to perform the first Passover. And sets this month as their first month of the year. The plague on the first born is about to occur.
0 yr	Ex 12:17	Celebrate the Feast of Unleavened Bread, because it was on this very day that I brought your divisions out of Egypt.
	Ex 12:29-30	Plague on first born occurs
	Ex 12:36	There were about 600,000 men. Not counting women and children.
	Ex 12:41	The children of Israel left Egypt 430 yr to the very day
	Ex 13:17-22	crossing the Rea Sea
	Ex 15:22-27	for 3 days they travel through the desert of Shur without water. Then the Lord makes the waters of Marah pure. Then they travel to Elim which had 12 springs.
	Ex 16:1	The children of Israel arrive at the desert of Sin on the 15th day of the 2nd month.
	Ex 17:8-16	Joshua leads Israelites to defeat Amalekites

Time	Ref (Ex)	Description
	Ex 18	Jethro visits Moses
	Ex 19	On the 3 rd month to the very day after leaving Egypt they enter desert of Sinai. God makes a covenant with the Israelites
	Ex 19:16	On the morning of the third day there was thunder and lightning, with a thick cloud over the mountain, and a very loud trumpet blast.
	Ex 20	10 commandments given
	Ex 23:20	God sends His angel to prepare the way.
	Ex 24:18	Then Moses entered the cloud as he went on up the mountain. And he stayed on the mountain forty days and forty nights.
	Ex 25-39	God reveals to Moses how to build the tabernacle and all the utensils.
	Ex 34:28	Moses was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights without eating bread or drinking water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant—the Ten Commandments.
1 yr	Ex 40:17	So the tabernacle was set up on the first day of the first month in the second year.
1 yr 1 st Mon	Num 9:1	The Lord spoke to Moses in the 1 st month of the 2 nd year. Celebrate Passover.
1 yr 2 nd Mon	Num 1:1	1 st day of the 2 nd month of the 2 nd year, God has Moses take a census.
1 yr 2 nd Mon	Num 10:11	On the 20 th day of the 2 nd month of the 2 nd year, the Israelites leave the desert of Sinai.
1 yr 7 th Mon	Lev 16:34	The 1 st Day of Atonement (scripture says that it was done). 10 th day of the 7 th month. Must be the 2 nd year because the tabernacle was not setup at this time of the 1 st year.
